WOOLFORD PROVINCIAL PARK

FIRSTLY:

All that parcel or tract of land, situate, lying, and being in the second (2) township, in the twenty-fourth (24) range, west of the fourth (4) meridian, in the Province of Alberta, Canada, and being composed of:

All that portion of the north east quarter of section thirty-one (31) of the said township, being Id. 2 in the St. Mary River, as shown upon a map or plan of survey of the said township approved and confirmed at Ottawa on the twenty-third (23) day of August, nineteen hundred and twenty-two (1922), by T. Shanks, for the Surveyor General of Dominion Lands, and on file in the Department of Lands and Forests at Edmonton, containing one and ninety hundredths (1.90) acres, more or less.

SECONDLY:

All those parcels or tracts of land, situate, lying , and being in the third (3) township, in the twenty-fourth (24) range, west of the fourth (4) meridian, in the Province of Alberta, Canada, and being composed of:

- A) All that portion of the east half of section five (5) of the said township, being an island in the St. Mary's River which lies adjacent to the right arm of the said river, as shown upon a map or plan of survey of the said township approved and confirmed at Ottawa on the eleventh (11) day of November, eighteen hundred and eighty-nine (1889), by E. Deville, Surveyor General of Dominion Lands, and on file in the said Department of Lands and Forests, containing sixty-eight and twenty hundredths (68.20) acres, more or less.
- B) All that portion of the south east quarter of the said section five (5) of the said township, which lies generally to the north and east of the right bank of the said St. Mary's River, as shown upon a map or plan of survey of the said township approved and confirmed at Ottawa on the eleventh (11) day of November, eighteen hundred and eighty-nine (1889), by E. Deville, Surveyor General of Dominion Lands and on file in the said Department of Lands and Forests, containing seventeen (17.00) acres, more or less.
- C) All that portion of the statutory road allowance adjoining the south boundary of the said south east quarter of section five (5) of the said township, which lies within the said island containing thirty hundredths (0.30) of an acre, more or less.

SAVING AND EXCEPTING:

Out of the said south east quarter of section five (5), eighty-nine hundredths (0.89) of an acre, more or less, required for a surveyed roadway, as shown upon a plan of survey of the said roadway, on file in the Land Titles Office at Calgary for the South Alberta Land Registration District as No. 3761 B.M.

The lands herein described containing eighty-six and fifty-one hundredths (86.51) acres, more or less.
