




Queen Elizabeth Provincial Park, on the shores of Lac Cardinal, offers a lot in a small space.

The campground has 56 campsites, 42 with power, tucked into the forest along the lake shore. A group campsite can be booked for large gatherings. Barrier free campsites, washroom, trails and picnic shelter are available.

Lac Cardinal is a large shallow lake with abundant vegetation, ideal habitat for waterfowl. The boat launch is a popular access to the lake for boating, tubing and sailing and the beach is a great place to enjoy the summer sun. Lac Cardinal does not support a fish population.

A network of hiking trails wind along the shore and through the woods. Watch for some of the over 140 species of birds and other wildlife that have been recorded in the park.
