# Birds of Kananaskis Country Checklist

Kananaskis Country's mountains and foothills offer a wide variety of habitats which support a surprisingly rich bird life. Birds of the boreal forests, prairie grasslands and aspen parklands can all be found here in varying numbers, as well as a few highly-specialized birds which you won't see in Alberta outside of the Rocky Mountains.

As you make your way around our natural areas, please take care not to disturb the birds or other animals that you see. The breeding season is very short and living conditions harsh in the mountains; any disturbance at all can be costly to the species who live here.

This checklist includes 261 species that have been seen in Kananaskis Country. It is designed to be the companion to a recognized bird identification book such as Peterson's Field Guide to Western Birds, National Geographic Field Guide to the Birds of North America, the Golden Guide to Birds of North America or the Audubon Society Field Guide to North American Birds.

### **Abundance**

VR − Very Rare; R − Rare; U − Uncommon; FC − Fairly Common; C − Common; VC − Very Common or Abundant; (Species in brackets) − indicates that the bird's presence is unconfirmed or hypothetical.

\*\*Remember, these indications are very general.

A species listed as rare might be more common in the specific area you're visiting; check the 'Habitat' and 'Season' categories to get a better idea of what you're likely to see and when.

### **Habitats**

The "Habitat" category indicates the environment in which that bird is most likely to be seen.

Remember that birds are not confined to these areas, and very often pass through a variety of habitats as they go about their daily business.

A - Alpine meadow (open areas above tree line);

C — Coniferous Forest (pine, spruce, fir);

D — Deciduous forests (aspens, poplars, often with open areas);
G — Grasslands;
H — Human settlement (buildings, bridges, etc.);
L — Ledges and Cliffs;
M — Mixed Forest;
O — Open water (large ponds and

M — Mixed Forest; O — Open water (large ponds and lakes); R — Rivers and large creeks; S — Shrubby areas (willow thickets, buckbrush/rose tangles); W — Wetlands (small ponds, fens, marshes).

**S** — Summer; **W** — Winter; **M** — Migrant (passes through in spring and/or autumn); **R** — Resident (present year-round).

# **Breeding Status**

An asterisk (\*) beside a species' name indicates that it is known to breed in the area.
