




Welcome to Oldman Dam Provincial Recreation Area.

Windy Point, Boulder Run, Todd Creek, North Fork, Island View, Cottonwood and Castle River Day Use Areas are open to foot access all year round; vehicle access is permitted during the summer season.

Cottonwood Campground

Open summer season only; first-come, first-serve and by reservation through reserve.albertaparks.ca or by calling 1–877–537–2757; potable water available for the summer season.

Enjoy shady, quiet, riverside camping, just minutes from the Oldman Reservoir and 10 minutes from the Town of Pincher Creek. There are 82 campsites under a lush grove of cottonwood trees, available first comefirst serve and through reserve.albertaparks.ca. There are both powered and basic sites to choose from! Firewood available for sale.


Three Rivers Group Camp
