Self-Registration

Campsites at the Figure Eight Lake Provincial Recreation Area are on self-registration. Once you have paid for your site, you must immediately occupy the campsite designated by your camping permit with your camping accommodation unit (tent, trailer, RV). If an accommodation unit is not present, the campsite may be re-assigned.

Campfires

Campfires are prohibited except in designated fire pits and must be extinguished when the campsite is unoccupied. Firewood is provided for the campsite and the day users. Removal of firewood from the Provincial Recreation Area is not permitted.
