## APPENDIX

### SCHEDULE 3

#### BLERIOT FERRY PROVINCIAL RECREATION AREA

All those parcels or tracts of land, situate, lying and being in the thirtieth (30) township, in the twenty-first (21) range, west of the fourth (4) meridian, in the Province of Alberta, Canada, and being composed of:

- (A) All that portion of the south west quarter of section fifteen (15) of the said township required for a campsite, as shown upon a plan of survey of record in the Land Titles Office at Calgary for the South Alberta Land Registration District as No. 735 I.X., containing one and eight hundred ninety-four thousandths (1.894) hectares (4.68 acres), more or less.
- (B) All that portion of the south west quarter of the said section fifteen (15) of the said township required for Area 'A' as shown upon a plan of survey of record in the said Land Titles Office at Calgary as No. 151 3330, containing two and eight hundred ninety-nine thousandths (2.899) hectares (7.16 acres), more or less.

The lands herein described contain five and two hundred thirty thousandths (5.230) hectares (12.92 acres), more or less.
