Beautiful Sir Winston Churchill Provincial Park is Alberta's only park of islands. The main island, Big Island, is in the east basin of Lac La Biche. It is accessible by a 2.5 kilometre-long causeway and is just 11 kilometres northeast of the town of Lac La Biche.

Site Registration Building

Allows campers to check-in at the tipi site without driving into campground.

Tipis #16-17

- Tipis with 4 single raised platform beds that may be re-arranged.
- Access to a private full-serviced bathroom.
- Access to a full-serviced enclosed cook-house (similar to the kitchens of the cabins), BBQ, and outdoor fire pit.

What to Bring

- Food and beverages

- Appropriate clothing and footwear, hat and sunglasses.



Rules

Check-in time is 4 p.m. Check-out time is 11 a.m.

Pets are not allowed inside comfort camping units aside from designated units, with the exception of registered service animals. Users of service animals should have government-issued identification cards for confirmation.

Smoking and/or vaping of tobacco and cannabis is strictly prohibited inside the unit and on the deck.

Cultural Programming

Indigenous cultural experiences and programs are available through the Lac La Biche Canadian Native Friendship Centre. Activities are customizable based on group size, interests and time of year.
